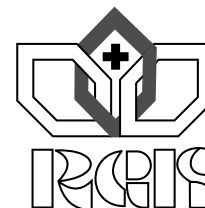

## **Case History:**

This 72-year-old gentleman, a known Diabetic patient was implanted Permanent Pacemaker in 2003 for Complete Heart Block. Since then Pacemaker site was infected 3 times in right side for which left sided Permanent Pacemaker was introduced on 2005-2006. This left sided Pacemaker was protruded since 1 month prior to admission. This time after proper Diabetic control and informed consent, left sided pacemaker was explanted with pulse generator and lead and fresh Pacemaker (Epicardial) was implanted under local Anesthesia on 10/05/2011.

Post procedure period was uneventful. Patient was discharged in a haemodynamically stable condition.
